



Farm & Agricultural Safety Fall Hazard Checklist

Location	
Do a	Falls from one level to another greater than 4 feet. Walking or working surfaces that are slippery, icy or wet. Work being done in a precarious position. Handling,moving or manipulating objects while off the ground. Standing on or using unstable structures.
00000	Risk of falling into or onto dangerous equipment or energized wires. Floor holes more than 2 inches in diameter. Wall openings more than 18 inches wide by 30 inches high. Vents, holes, skylights or other openings in a roof. Trenches, excavations or other ground being worked. Repair pits for working under equipment or tractors.
Othe	er things to look for: Are all stairs in good condition? Are all ladders in good condition? Are all guardrails in good repair? Are all steps and handholds for mounting/dismounting tractors or machinery in good condition?
_ 	Are all fall arrest systems and ladder safety systems, including required personal protective equipment, inspected before each use? Are all fall protection systems inspected annually by a competent person? Is everyone trained to recognize, evaluate and control fall hazards?
